ITINERARY DESCRIPTION

Day 1: Saigon to Tra Vinh (L, D/Cycling 55 km)

On the first day of your cycling tour from Saigon to Phnom Penh, you will start in the bustling city of Saigon (Ho Chi Minh City) and cycle towards the southwest to Tra Vinh. The biking distance between Long An and Tra Vinh is approximately 60 kilometers. As you leave the city, you'll pass through the beautiful Mekong Delta region, famous for its fertile land and abundance of fruit orchards. Along the way, you'll have the chance to witness the local way of life, with farmers working in the fields and small villages dotted along the route.

Inclusion: Support pickup van/minivan (carry the suitcase, bike & transfer the riders), biking guide(s), Cuu Long Tra Vinh hotel, Mt.bike, helmet, ferry, snack, drinking water, fruit.

Day 2: Tra Vinh to Can Tho (B, L/Cycling 60 km)

On the second day, you will continue your journey from Tra Vinh to Can Tho. This leg of the tour covers a distance of around 90 kilometers. As you cycle through the Mekong Delta, you'll pass by lush rice paddies and small canals. Can Tho, the largest city in the region, is known for its floating markets, where locals trade and sell various goods from their boats. This is a unique opportunity to experience the vibrant atmosphere and taste some delicious local fruits and delicacies.

Inclusion: Support pickup van/minivan (carry the suitcase, bike & transfer the riders), biking guide(s), Ninh Kieu Riverside hotel, Mt.bike, helmet, ferry, snack, drinking water, fruit.





Day 3: Can Tho to Chau Doc (B, L, D/Cycling 55 km)

From Can Tho, you'll cycle towards the Cambodian border town of Chau Doc, covering approximately 120 kilometers. Along the way, you'll pass through quaint villages, where the locals engage in traditional crafts such as rice paper-making and fishing. Chau Doc itself is a charming town located on the banks of the Hau River. You can explore its vibrant markets, visit religious sites like the Chau Doc Lady Temple, and even take a boat tour to see some of the nearby floating fish farms.

Inclusion: Support pickup van/minivan (carry the suitcase, bike & transfer the riders), biking guide(s), Chau Pho Chau Doc hotel, Mt.bike, helmet, ferry, snack, drinking water, fruit

Day 4: Chau Doc to Phnom Penh (B/No Cycling)

On the final day of our Mekong cycling tour 4 days, following the breakfast you will take an early morning speedboat from Chau Doc to Phnom Penh, the capital city of Cambodia. The boat journey takes around 4-5 hours: boat trip is a chance to enjoy the scenic views along the Mekong River and experience the local life along its banks, you will arrive in Phnom Penh in the noon time. End of our service after the boat trip !

Inclusion: Speedboat ticket, breakfast, brunch, transfer by local vehicle.
